Dear Shri Kumar,

The flagship scheme of the Government of India, Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) has completed two years last month. This Ministry has been implementing the Mission to address the estimated housing shortage in urban areas of the country.

- The assessment of housing demand is an important activity under the Mission as the city-wise demand will form the basis for preparation of Housing for All Plan of Action (HFAPoA) and the Annual Implementation Plan (AIP). Accordingly, States/Cities have been mandated to prepare HFAPoA based on demand, phasing out, vertical-wise and the number of houses targeted to be constructed each year. This Ministry has therefore been, through various communications and at various fora such as CSMC meetings and National/Regional Workshops, etc., pursuing the matter for completion of demand assessment and preparation of HFAPoA/AIP with the States/UTs.
- 3. As per the report of the Technical Group (TG-12), constituted by this Ministry for estimating the urban housing shortage of the country for the 12th Five Year Plan (2012-17), the total housing shortage estimated at the beginning of 12th Plan Period (i.e. in 2012) for the State of Uttar pradesh was 30.70 lakhs. However, on 31.05.2017, total demand registered, through various sources viz. PMAY-MIS Portal, CSC and by ULBs, under PMAY (U) Mission in the State is 23,93,734. This demand also does not represent the net actual demand of urban housing as these are yet to be validated by the States/UTs. The States/UTs have been requested regularly to complete the demand assessment process so that net/actual demand under the Mission may be derived and Road Map be prepared for achieving the goal of housing for all by 2022. I, therefore, request you that the status of validation of demand may please be furnished to this Ministry by 30.7.2017 in the enclosed format (Annexure-1) without any fail.
- 4. Further, you are aware that the Mission period is upto March, 2022 and construction of houses under the Mission requires certain time period for completion. Also, the beneficiary details collected during the demand survey need to be entered in the PMAY-MIS System. I would, therefore, request you to first validate the demand registered till 31.05.2017 and HFAPoA/AIP may accordingly be submitted to this Ministry at the earliest. It is clarified that the demand received after 31.05.2017 from potential beneficiaries may be taken up subsequently.
- 5. I would like to emphasise that the North-Eastern States, smaller States like Kerala & Goa, Hilly States (Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir) and all UTs should

saturate their total demand for sanction in the year 2017-18 itself, which will enable them to complete all the houses by 2020. All other States should saturate their 50% of demand for sanction in 2017-18 and balance 50% in 2018-19. This will help these States to complete all houses by 2021. States/UTs are required to make sufficient budgetary provision accordingly. All types of clearances required under PMAY (U) Mission should be put in place under fast pace or time-bound single window system keeping in view the Road-Map for achieving the goal of housing for all by 2022.

- Progress of all States/UTs under the Scheme is enclosed as Annexure-2 for your perusal and review.
- 7. In the above background, following are the summary of the activities to be fast tracked by all the States/UTs:
  - The total demand registered till 31.5.2017 under the Mission are to be Rationalised, Validated and Confirmed.
  - Ensuring appropriate budgetary provisions and availability of land for the housing projects under PMAY (U).
  - Submission of project proposals to be fast tracked in accordance with the strategy illustrated at Para 5 above.
  - All mandatory reforms under the Mission and all types of clearances should be put in place for facilitating timely completion of projects under the Mission.
- 8. The issues related with progress of PMAY (U) were reviewed by the Hon'ble Prime Minister during PRAGATI meeting on 12/07/2017 and earlier in February, 2017. Keeping in view the objective of the Mission to provide Pucca houses to all when the nation celebrates 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Independence, I request your personal attention to accord highest priority to PMAY (U) and review the Scheme regularly.
